### **DRAFT Meeting Notes – of meeting 7<sup>th</sup> April 2022@ 7:30pm via Zoom**

This was the eleventh meeting of the working group established at the Parish Council meeting on 9<sup>th</sup> February 2021.

1. **Apologies for absence** – Chrissie Russell, David Landers, Jane Trahair, Mervyn Gingell, Hazel Claus
2. **Approval of notes of meeting of 2<sup>nd</sup> of March 2022**—attendees approved the notes of the meeting.
3. **Planting of Chestnut trees** – thank you to Paul and Hayley who have planted them at the end of Tideford Road. There has been a lot of positive feedback about the beautiful daffodils around the village.
4. **Newsletter** – We are hoping a newsletter will be out in May.
5. **Offroad walking paths update** – Kathy and Sara are coordinating to identify further footpaths. Kathy is putting together details of a couple of routes that are now available to us locally. Some of this work has been delayed due to Covid. A walk is planned in late April – date to follow. We are asking the Parish Council for better signage at Hay Lake.
6. **Letter to landowners regarding green space** Disappointingly there has been no response to the letter circulated to landowners.
7. **Closer working with Sir Robert Geoffrey's school.** Paul and Hayley are on the School Farm Committee that is a great connection.
